31st District Court Community Service Rules & Regulations

THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED WHEN WORKING:

- 1. Participation in the community service program is a choice made by you in lieu of a jail sentence. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the community service program will result in a jail sentence being enforced.
- 2. You are to report for community service from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Late reporting, even 1 MINUTE, will result in being sent home, and marked absent. Report no matter the weather conditions.
- 3. You must report on the assigned day. Failure to report will be considered a violation and a warrant issued for your arrest. Should you miss community service you should report to the Court on the following Monday at 8:00 a.m. to present your explanation for missing community service. Do not call the Court.
- 4. You will report to the 31st District Court, Hamtramck City Hall, 3401 Evaline on the following dates:
- 5. You are responsible for wearing proper work clothing and dressing for bad weather. Bring work gloves.
- 6. You are required to complete the community service project assigned. A passing grade will earn credit for the worked day. A failing grade will result in a show cause hearing and non-credit for the worked day.
- 7. You must sign a form that the supervisor has both prior to and after your work shift. If you are given a tool to work with, you will be responsible for turning in that tool at the end of the day. Failure to do so will result in a jail sentence and reimbursement for the cost of the tool.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Your participation in the 31st District Court Community Service program will be evaluated daily on a pass/fail basis. Those that do not participate to the standards of the Court will be given a failing grade and no credit given for that day. Failure to participate/cooperate will result in being sent home. A hearing will be held the following Monday morning to determine if there is a violation of the performance standard. If you are found in violation of that standard a jail sentencing may be imposed.
